



Step 1: Practise the skill in the kitchen

Not yet? That's okay go back to step 1 for a while

Do you bet me £20 your dog will do the behaviour every time you ask?

ABSOLUTELY!

Step 2: Practise in the back garden

Ready to make the bet again? You know what to do! Don't be afraid to go back a step if you need to

Ready to bet £20 they can do it in the garden?

Not quite!

Step 3: Practise in the front garden/drive

ABSOLUTELY!

Step 4: Practise on the street outside your house

You probably spent more time working there before you were ready to place your bet, that's perfectly normal!

Is your dog performing the behaviour perfectly in this location every time you ask?

Not quite!

We've got this!

Step 5: Practise in a new, quiet location. Like an empty carpark or street

Step 6: Head to your goal location ie. the park or woods but don't go in yet! Practise in the carpark or just outside

This time increase that bet to £50, we've got this far we don't want to rush now!

Step 7: Head inside, but stick to the edge to start with gradually getting closer to the distractions

£50 says they can do it at step 6!
